**Category 6 Communication Cable Requirements**

I have found a few mistakes in the earlier sent survey of Category 5e cable requirements. These failures are mostly evident or editorial, but also a confusing return loss failure was found and is now corrected. 3P will maintain and update this and other surveys in our homepage so that updated documents can be downloaded anytime from there. You can conclude any updates from the specified date which will be the key to the latest issue. Modifications will not be indicated in the updated documents.

I have continued the evaluation of cable requirements in international standards by concluding Category 6 communication cable performance. This survey has now been updated and is attached as file "Category 6 Communication Cable Requirements".

Category 6 cable specifications have many more or less significant differences in requirements, like was the case for Category 5e. Also for Category 6 most differences are marginal and will not result in any significant change in performance for major cable parameters.

The attached document is of course subject to change according to modified or changed requirements incorporated into new drafts that may be developed.

3P must make reservation for printing errors or mistakes in the written requirements. Correctness of limits of the different parameters must of course always be checked in the relevant specifications.
